- Apprenticeship Committee** - This committee is one half of the joint committee, working with committee members from SMART Local 12, responsible for apprentice training. This committee generally meets every other month with additional meetings to interview apprentices.

- Budget and Finance Committee** - This committee develops and recommends to the Board of Directors, an annual operating budget for the Association. It also requires a certified audit of the Association's finances, which shall be reviewed by the Board annually. This committee will typically meet once per year.

- By-Laws Committee** - This committee reviews and updates the Association's by-laws as necessary. This committee meets as needed or as determined by the President of the Association.

- Health and Welfare/Annuity Trustees** - These are the trustees responsible for the overseeing and administration of Local 12's Welfare and Annuity programs along with the representatives of organized labor. This committee shall be elected by the Board of Directors for a period of four (4) years. This committee meets every 6-8 weeks for approximately 4-6 hours per meeting.

- Legislative Committee** - The Legislative Committee shall deal with governmental agencies when required for general matters pertaining to licensing, standardization codes, proposed legislation and related matters concerning the sheet metal industry. This committee meets as needed and also generally attends the SMACNA Legislative Conference in Washington, DC annually.

- Safety Committee** - The Safety Committee shall attend all safety-related functions involving the Association and keep members informed about safety-related matters. This committee meets as needed and typically holds 1-2 Safety Roundtables annually where industry issues are discussed.
